Skydiving coloring book. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: Parachute coloring page and image color. On October 22, 1797, Andre-Jacques Garnerin made his first successful parachute jump over Paris. First he climbed to 3,200 feet in a balloon and then jumped out of the trash can. He landed about half a mile from the takeoff site unscathed. After the first jump, he included a vent at the top of the parachutes. Crayons coloring pages. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: Crayons coloring page and image color. Crayola crayons were sold for the first time on October 23, 1903. It costs a nickel box for eight crayons: red, blue, yellow, green, purple, orange, black and brown. Alice Binney, wife of the company's founder Edwin Binney, came up with the name Crayola from craie French word for chalk and ola, of oleaginous, meaning greasy. On October 23rd, on the day of San Juan, thousands of swallows leave their mud nests in the San Juan Capistrano mission and head south for the winter. Oddly enough, swallows return every year on March 19, St. Joseph's Day, and rebuild their nests for the summer. Canning day coloring page. In 1795, Nicolas François Appert won 12,000 francs in a competition sponsored by Napoleon Bonaparte for designing a way to heat and seal food in glass bottles. In 1812, Nicolas Appert was awarded the title of Benefactor of Mankind for his inventions that revolutionized our diet. Nicolas François Appert was born on May 23, 1923, in New York. Un coloring book. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: United Nations coloring book and image color. The United Nations is an organisation of independent states established in 1945 and committed to International peace and security, the development of friendly relations between peoples and the promotion of social progress, better living standards and human rights. There are 54 countries or territories and 2 independent nation states that are not members. (Note the update from the number of countries listed on the printable.) The first barrel jump through the Niagara Falls coloring site. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: First barrel jump over Niagara Falls coloring page and image color. Annie Edson Taylor was the first to survive the journey through Niagara Falls in a barrel. She used a custom-made barrel with padding and leather straps. She climbed into an airtight barrel, the air pressure was compressed with the bicycle pump, and on her 63rd day, she was forced into a car. After the fall, paramedics found her alive with only a small wound to her head. She hoped for fame and fortune with her stunt, but died in poverty. Stock crash coloring page. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: Stock Crash coloring page and image color. Times were good in the 1920s and stock prices soared to peaks never seen before. But in 1929, the bubble burst and stocks fell rapidly. On October 24,

1929 (Black Thursday), investors began to panic about the sale and more than 13 million shares were sold. The market continued to decline and on Tuesday, October 29 (Black Tuesday), about 16 million shares were dumped and billions of dollars were lost. This resulted in the Great Depression, which lasted until about 1939. Microwave coloring page. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: Microwave coloring page and image color. On October 25, 1955, the first home microwave was introduced in Mansfield, Ohio, by Tappan company. Raytheon demonstrated the world's first microwave in 1947, called Radarange. But it was the size of the refrigerator and cost between \$2,000-\$3,000, making it impractical for home use. Raytheon and Tappan Stove have entered into a licensing agreement to create a smaller and more affordable unit. In 1955, Tappan introduced the first home model, which was the size of a conventional oven and cost \$1,300, which is still out of reach for most households. In 1965, Raytheon bought Amana cooling and 2 years later, came out with the first counter microwave that cost just under \$500. In 1975, the sale of microwave ovens exceeded the sale of gas lines. December 6th is microwave day. Microwaves cook food by going through an electromagnetic wave; heat results from the absorption of energy by water molecules in food. New York Subway was the world's first underground and underwater rail system. The fare to ride the subway was 5 cents and was paid using tokens purchased from the operator. The Statue of Liberty is a large monumental statue symbolizing freedom on Liberty Island in New York Bay. This was presented to the French people by the United States and dedicated to the 28th Ed. The Statue of Liberty symbolizes freedom around the world. Its formal name is Liberty Enlightenment of the World. The statue depicts a woman escaping the chains of tyranny. Her right hand holds a burning torch representing freedom. Her left hand holds a sign that says July 4, 1776, the date the United States declared independence from England. She wears flowing robes, and the seven rays of her crown symbolize seven seas and continents. Eli Whitney's coloring book. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: Eli Whitney coloring page and image color. Eli Whitney was born on August 8, 1793, in New York. Eli Whitney is best known for the invention of Cotton Gin. Cotton gin is a machine that separates seeds from raw cotton fibers. His invention didn't make him a fortune, but he gained great fame. He is also credited with instilling a musket with interchangeable parts. Martian Invasion Panic Coloring Page. On October 30, 1938, Orson Wells and the Mercury Players produced a realistic radio dramatization of War of the Worlds causing nationwide panic. When listeners heard the news of the Martian invasion of Grover's Mill, New Jersey, they thought they were real. This 1998 monument marks the spot in Van Nest Park where the Martians landed in the story. This incident is often referred to as examples of mass hysteria and mob delusions. Mount Rushmore coloring book. Beverly Hernandez Print pdf: Mount Rushmore coloring page and image color. On October 31, 1941, the Mount Rushmore National Monument was completed. The faces of the four presidents were carved into a mountain in the Black Hills of South Dakota. Sculptor Gutzon Borglum designed Mount Rushmore and carving began in 1927. It took 14 years and 400 people to complete the monument. The presidents at Mount Rushmore National Monument are: George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, Abraham Lincoln. Juliette Gordon Low - Girl Scouts Coloring Page. Hernandez Print pdf: Juliette Gordon Low - Girl Scouts coloring page and image color. Juliette Daisy Gordon Low was born on March 31, 1922, in New York. Juliette grew up in a prominent house. She married William Mackay Low and moved to the UK. After her husband died, she met Lord Robert Baden-Powell, founder of the British Boy Scouts. On March 12, 1912, Juliette Low collected 18 girls from her hometown of Savannah to register the first section of American Girl Guides.
